Friuli Venezia Giulia, no case of coronavirus in the region Eight answers to Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Villa Chiozza di Cervignano, 28th February - At the moment no case of coronavirus has been yet ascertained in Friuli Venezia Giulia. The situation is constantly monitored by the local health authorities. PromoTurismoFVG, the regional body for the promotion and management of tourism, has activated all the necessary procedures to protect tourists, in compliance with the measures decided by the Ministry and the Region to address the exceptional situation.

Some temporary measures have been adopted until March 1, such as the suspension of events in public or private places that involve gathering and closing of museums and other institutes and places of culture (libraries and archives, areas and parks archaeological sites, monumental complexes), aimed solely at protecting residents and guests in the area.

Some measures have been adopted in line with national provisions: disinfectant gel dispensers have been installed in the 18 PromoTurismoFVG Infopoints.

The region continues to record the presence of tourists from all over Europe who can find guided tours, excursions and outdoor activities in all the tourist resorts in the region.

Starting from yesterday, on the homepage of the website www.turismofvg.it, the 8 answers to the most Frequent Asked Questions (FAQ) that have been collected in these days in the region's Infopoints are online. The replies, which represent a tool for the tourist, have also been translated into English and German and will be implemented in the coming days according to the different requests from users. This is another of the tools activated by PromoTurismoFVG's "crisis committee", which has been active with daily meetings since last week and has started to implement strategies for emergency management and to coordinate the correct communications in the 4 main areas:

- employees
- stakeholders and operators
- the press and the media
- tourists

with continuous attention to the well-being of the residents and guests of Friuli Venezia Giulia.
