THE VENUE

3. TARVISIO - TARVISIO, WHERE SPORT UNITES

In the beating heart of the Julian Alps, Tarvisio is far more than just a ski resort—it's a crossroads of cultures, nations, and sporting passion. Here, where Italy, Austria, and Slovenia meet, every slope, trail, and peak tells a story of borders, challenge, and unity.

At the center of this unique setting rises **Monte Lussari**—a spiritual and sporting icon of the region. From its summit unfolds the legendary **Di Prampero slope**, one of the most thrilling downhill runs in the Alpine arc. With over 1,000 meters of vertical drop, it's a proving ground for expert skiers and World Cup athletes alike—where technique, speed, and breathtaking views converge into one unforgettable experience. Every turn is a passage between earth and sky, between challenge and triumph.

Here, the concept of the **Three Borders** takes on a symbolic dimension—not as separation, but as connection. In Tarvisio, sport becomes a unifying force, breaking down barriers and building bridges—between languages, cultures, and athletes from across Europe. Competing here means more than racing:



it means connecting, learning, and growing.

Tarvisio is a constant sporting challenge—and at the same time, an open invitation to share in something greater. The Three Borders become the **beating European heart of alpine skiing**, where competition meets camaraderie, and rivalries evolve into mutual respect and cooperation. When snow blankets the landscape and silence settles over the woods, the Di Prampero transforms into an elite training ground for national teams and a natural spectacle for spectators. During international competitions, the atmosphere in Tarvisio crackles with adrenaline—fans arrive from all over Europe, and the race village pulses with life, just steps from the slopes.

Tarvisio made its World Cup debut in 2007, with Austria's Renate Götschl taking the Super-G, the USA's Julia Mancuso winning the downhill, and Nicole Hosp of Austria claiming the combined. The event returned in 2009, when the legendary Lindsey Vonn won the Super-G, while Germany dominated the downhill (Stechert) and the combined (Riesch).

In **2011,** Vonn once again took the Super-G, **Anja Paerson** of Sweden triumphed in the downhill, and **Tina Maze** of Slovenia secured the combined victory.

THE FIELD OF PLAY

4.1 THE DI PRAMPERO SLOPE: WHERE SKIING BECOMES LEGEND

Where the Julian Alps plunge into the valley and speed meets history, an iconic slope is born: the Di Prampero. Pride of Tarvisio, cradle of Italian speed. A run that makes amateurs dream and champions tremble.

FROM HEROIC BEGINNINGS TO A WORLD-CLASS TRACK

1958

THE ADVENTURE BEGINS

A pioneering gondola whisks the first dreamers from Valbruna up to Monte Lussari. From there, it's a thrilling descent to Camporosso—then back to Valbruna by shuttle. Skiing was pure passion.

1982

THE LUSSARI S.P.A. CHALLENGE

A new lift system breathes life into the resort, but the company folds. In 1993, Promotur steps in—clear vision, bold ambition.

2000

THE TRUE DI PRAMPERO TAKES SHAPE

On December 29, a new lift opens from Camporosso. The Di Prampero slope, designed by Luciano Lazzaro and built by Wieser of Campo Tures, is born—crafted for both tourism and international racing. At first, artificial snow covers only the final two walls. But the goal is clear: elevate Friuli's mountains to greatness.











2001

FIS CERTIFICATION AND SAFETY UPGRADES

Ahead of the 2003 Winter Universiade, the slope is updated to meet FIS safety standards. Instrumental to the process was Helmut Schmalzl—former coach of the Italian national team and FIS Race Director for men's speed events. In his honor, a curve before the mid-station is named "Schmalzl Curve."

Technical experts Kurt Hoch and Jan Tischhauser (FIS) conduct the inspection and recommend a new course variant. In 2006, the FIS Variant is built—enhancing safety and competitiveness.

A FIRE THAT COULDN'T EXTINGUISH A DREAM

On November 8, 2005, a fire devastates the top station of the gondola. For many, it's the end. But not for Tarvisio. In true mountain spirit, a miracle happens: by January 20, 2006, the lift is back in operation. A record-breaking comeback. Di Prampero lives on—stronger than ever.

ENTRY DEADLINES AND REQUIREMENTS

(III) Preliminary Entries

Deadline: 11 December 2025

National Ski Associations must inform the Organizing Committee of the expected total team size (athletes, coaches, staff, etc.) at least 5 weeks before the first competition, as per FIS rules.

Final Entries

Deadline: 8 January 2026

Final team lists (athletes, staff, officials) must be submitted no later than 7 days before the first official training (speed).

- Late or missing entries may result in charges for unused accommodations (FIS art. 4).
- Entry Submission

Only entries submitted via the official FIS Online Entry System and within deadlines will be accepted.

6.2 **ACCOMMODATION**

Official Arrival Date: 14 January 2026

Official Departure Date: 19 January 2026

(III) Accommodation will be provided in Tarvisio, max 20 km by car from the competition venue. In accordance with FIS regulations (Art. 4.1 and 4.2), the Organizing Committee (OC) will cover accommodation expenses for athletes and team officials within the official quota during the official event dates.

Despite being located only 754 m above sea level, Tarvisio has a continental climate with cold and very snowy winters. February and March are generally cold months. The average temperature is 0.4 °C, with a minimum of -3.7 °C and a maximum of 4.4 °C.

The regional meteorological agency <u>OSMER ARPA FVG</u> will be responsible for carrying out the surveys on the competition fields.
